Storage: Excellent Resistant: Scab</p>	<p>RED Adirondack</p> <p>Season: Mid- to Late Description: Tubers oblong, shallow eyes, and red flesh. Storage: Excellent Resistance: Late blight</p>	<p>Chieftain</p> <p>Season: Early- to Mid Description: Round Tubers with shallow eyes, red skin and white flesh. Storage: Fair Resistance: Scab—highly resistant</p>
<p>Kennebec</p> <p>Season: Mid Description: Large, oblong tubers with thin, buff skin, unobtrusive eyes and moist, firm, creamy-white flesh. Storage: Excellent Resistance: Late blight</p>	<p>Katahdin</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Round tubers with buff skin, white flesh, and high dependable yields. Storage: Excellent Resistance: Scab—medium resistance TIPS: Tubers tend to be near surface so it should be well hilled.</p>	<p>RED Pontiac</p> <p>Season: Early- to Mid Description: Round tubers with red skin, medium-deep eyes and white flesh. Storage: Excellent Resistance: Scab—medium, good drought tolerance.</p>
<p>Superior</p> <p>Season: Early Description: Smooth, oval tubers with buff skin and white flesh. Storage: Good for long storage Resistance: Heat, drought, and scab.</p>	<p>Red Norland</p> <p>Season: Early Description: Smooth tubers with dark-red skin and white flesh. Storage: Fair Resistance: Scab—highly resistant, and leaf roll.</p>	<p>Yukon</p> <p>Season: Very Early Description: Medium, oval tubers with thin, golden buff-yellow skin, small pink eyes and dry, mealy yellow flesh. Storage: Excellent Resistance: N/A Susceptible: Common scab, early blight, and fusarium.</p>
<p>Russet</p> <p>Season: Very Late Description: Long, heavy tubers with russeted skin and white flesh. Storage: Excellent Resistance: Blackleg, fusarium, and scab—highly resistant.</p>	<p>Banana Fingerling</p> <p>Season: Mid- to Late Description: Small, fingerling tubers, tan skin, dark yellow flesh, and slightly knobby. Storage: Good Resistance: Scab Susceptible: Light blight</p>	<p>French Fingerling</p> <p>Season: Mid- to Late Description: Large, fingerling tubers, dark rose-red skin and waxy yellow flesh, lightly splashed with pink. Storage: Good Resistance: Scab—highly resistant.</p>

<p>Yellow Danvers</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Highly productive, round, yellow-flesh with brownish skin. Storage: Poor</p>	<p>White Silverskin</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Medium-size, oblate in shape with slightly flat top and bottom.</p>	<p>Golden Globe</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Medium-size, oblate in shape with flat top and bottom, reddish-yellow skin and yellow flesh. Storage: Excellent</p>
<p>Red Weatherfield</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Large-size, oblate in shape with slightly flat top and bottom, purple skin and flesh with a strong flavor. Storage: Good</p>	<p>Stuttgarter</p> <p>Season: Late Description: Large-size, slightly flat top and bottom, yellow skin and pale yellow flesh. Storage: Good</p>	<p>Onion Bunch</p> <p>Season: Mid Description: Large, sweet, mild onion perfect for hamburgers, orange-yellow skin with pale yellow flesh. Storage: Poor</p>
<p>Dutch Shallots</p> <p>Season: Mid Description: Known as the ‘multiplier onion’, has orange-yellow skin and white flesh. Storage: Poor</p>	<p>Jersey Supreme Asparagus</p> <p>Season: Early, cold tolerant Description: Slender to medium in diameter spears, green in color, uniform size. Resistance: Rust and fusarium</p>	<p>Purple Passion Asparagus</p> <p>Season: Early Description: Large spears, purple in color that turn green when cooked, slight nutty flavor, sweeter and milder flavor than the green. Susceptible: Rust</p>
